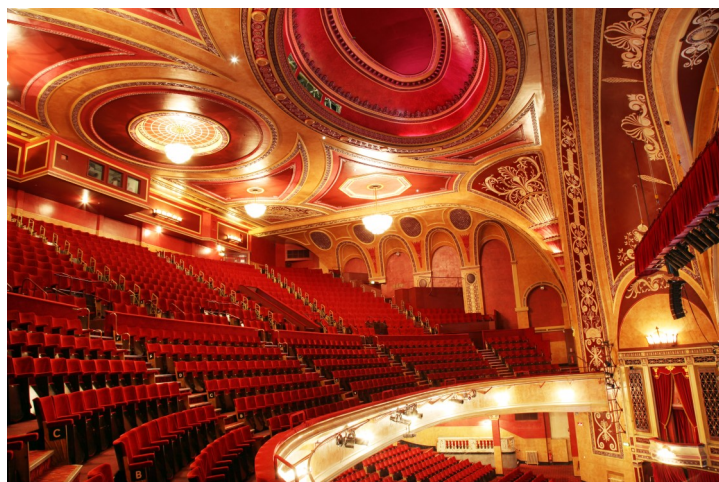
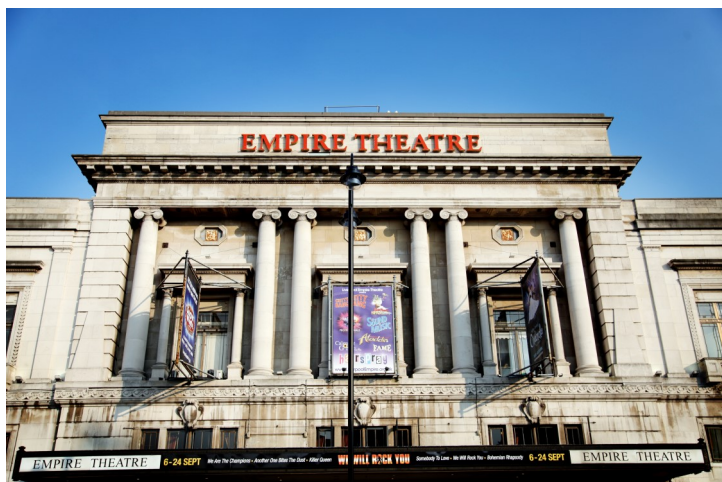

## Re-installing opera glasses in Liverpool...

Liverpool's Empire Theatre is the second to be built on its site; it was opened in 1925 and replaced the original theatre building as the owners at the time, Moss Empires, felt it needed to be larger and grander. They certainly achieved their aim: the theatre now has the largest two-tier auditorium in Britain and can seat 2,381 people!

Following the installation of new seating throughout the circle during September this year, we have been working closely with the theatre's General Manager Diane Belding and BOH Operations Director Gail Wroth in order to reinstall our opera glasses in the auditorium.



## ...and Bradford

Since its grand opening in 1914, Bradford's Alhambra Theatre has played host to a huge variety of national and international performances and entertainment extravaganzas. In 1964, Bradford City Council bought the Alhambra and has maintained its operation ever since. In 1974, the theatre was designated a Grade II listed building, and underwent extensive renovation in 1986.

Earlier this month, the refurbishment of seats in the upper circle was completed. We have since reinstalled our opera glasses onto the new seats, and would like to extend our thanks to Bev Barnes, Theatres Operations Administrative Officer, for her assistance throughout this process.
